IV. Social Contribution Activity

① Petit Cool Biz (Cooperation for the government's energy-saving project)

Takefuji Corporation has cooperated for the governments initiatives, called "Cool Biz." for saving energy in summer time by introducing a cool dress code. It encourages Takefujis male employees to wear half-sleeve shirts instead of long-sleeve shirts during Japanese humid summer, from July 1st to the end of September. Although we did not define exact room temperature, Lower than usual appeal decreased by 3,915 m³ gas amount in 2 months (July and August), and it also saved 8,652kg of carbon dioxide calculated by the emission coefficient.

The Takefuji Clean-up Campaign, which has been carried out once a month by the entire staff of the Company, entered the third year in this July. Also in November 2004, this Clean-up Campaign received **Small Kindness Movement Award** from The Japanese Small Kindness Movement Executive Office, the government-related incorporation, in Japan.
