Participated in the 57th Kurowashi all-Japan selected volleyball championship

Takefuji Bamboo participated in the 57th Kurowashi all-Japan selected volleyball championship, which started May 1, 2008. The tournament is for selected top 16 male volleyball teams and top 16 female volleyball teams in Japan, including V. Premier League teams and the champion of the all-Japan selected high school volleyball championship, or *Haruko Volleyball*. They compete for the national championship during a short period of the Golden Week holidays. Takefuji Bamboo advanced to the championship tournament, after winning the competitive elimination among 4 teams, 3 out of which were V. Premier teams at the second place with 2 victories and 1 defeat. The Bamboo won the quarter final against Okayama Seagulls with sets count of 3 to 2. At the following semi final against JT Marvelous, they lost with sets count of 2 to 3. The Bamboo could not make it to the final, but finished at the third place. With Ms. Yoshizawa being selected as the best 6 players for the second time after 2 years, the results cheered the team toward the 2008/09 V. Premier League.
