A Part of the Contents of the Financial Report

Takefuji Corporation submitted the Financial Report, or “YuHo,” to the Kanto Regional Finance Bureau on June 30, 2010. The Financial Report is available only in Japanese language. However, because capital market participants, including investors, are highly concerned about a part of the subsequent events disclosed in the report, we attach a tentative translation and disclose it on our website.

The same information is planned to be disclosed in our annual report in English, which is expected to be completed at the end of July, 2010.

Attachment

(Transfer of loans receivable)

The Group transferred a part of direct cash loans to customers as a part of its fund raising efforts. The details are as below. Extraordinary income or loss is expected to be recorded for the fiscal year ending March 2011 and the amount is calculated by deducting transfer price from the book value of the receivables, after offsetting the corresponding allowance for credit losses and the corresponding allowance for losses for refund of interest received from customers.

As for loans receivable, for which allowance for loss on transfer of receivables was recorded in the consolidated fiscal year under review, we are currently working toward the contract conclusion. Such loans receivable are not included in the transferred receivables below.

(Transfer of fixed assets)

The Group concluded transfer contracts for each of the properties from April 28, 2010 to June 18, 2010 and transferred a part of fixed assets (total 24 properties) as a part of its fund raising efforts. The details are as below. Gain or loss on transfer after deducting fees for the transfer etc. is expected to be recorded as extraordinary income or loss for the fiscal year ending March 2011.
